NOTIFICATION

The Department of Food Processing Industries & Horticulture, Government of West Bengal, hereby notifies the areas (Clusters/Districts/Blocks) (1) CLUSTER-I (Murshidabad, Coochbehar, Bankura, Jalpaiguri, Alipurduar & South 24 Parganas), (2) CLUSTER-II (Paschim Medinipur – including Jhargram, Nadia, Purulia & Dakshin Dinajpur), (3) CLUSTER-III (Burdwan – including Paschim Burdwan, Howrah, Birbhum & Malda) and (4) CLUSTER-IV (Uttar Dinajpur, North 24 Parganas, Hooghly, Darjeeling – including Kalimpong & Purba Medinipur), as detailed in Annexure—I, for implementation of Restructured Weather Based Crop Insurance Scheme (RWBCIS) as a component under 'Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana' (PMFBY) in respect of the horticultural crops, as detailed districtwise, in Annexure—I, during the Kharif Season, 2017, through the designated Implementing Agencies, as detailed in Annexure—I.

This Restructured Weather Based Crop Insurance Scheme (RWBCIS) for Horticultural Crops shall be implemented in the Kharif Season, 2017, with the Cut-off date for receipt of Proposals of from the 'Loanee' as well as the 'Non-Loanee' farmers being for RWBCIS, Kharif, 2017 would be 31st July, 2017 and Cut-off date for receipt of Declarations of 'Loanee' farmers covered on compulsory basis & 'Non-Loanee' farmers covered on Voluntary basis from Nodal Banks to Insurance Company for RWBCIS, Kharif, 2017 would be 16th August, 2017, and as per the following terms and conditions:

- Restructured Weather Based Crop Insurance Scheme (RWBCIS) will be compulsory for Loanee horticultural farmers, in the districts, by the participating insurance companies (public and private), as specified in Annexure-I. However, the scheme is optional for Non-Loanee horticultural farmers;
- 2. The Scheme shall operate on the principle of "Area Approach" in selected notified Reference Unit Areas. For all horticultural crops under RWBCIS, Block will be unit area;
- In Kharif Season, 2017, weather parameters e.g., Excess Temperature, Unseasonal Rainfall, Wind Speed and Excess Relative Humidity that may adversely affect the crop yield are considered as "Adverse Weather Incidence";
- 4. In case of horticultural crops under RWBCIS, the Implementing Agency will be responsible for all claims arising out of adverse weather incidence and shall settle claims strictly as per the terms and conditions of the notification to be issued by the Department of Food Processing Industries & Horticulture. Claims shall be assessed only on the basis of weather data recorded by the notified a AWS and the claim process shall commence on weather data being received;
- 5. The Food Processing & Horticulture Department has devised the "insurance Term Sheets" in respect of Weather-based Risk Coverage, Period of Coverage, Reference Weather Stations, Sum Insured, Maximum Payout, Payout Structures, Premium Payable by the Farmers, Premium Subsidy to be shared by the Central and State Governments and other relevant parameters. Copies of such Term Sheets have been kept in the Department of Food Processing Industries & Horticulture, Government of West Bengal and its sub-Offices, and Insurance Companies;

- 6. Maximum of 5% of Sum Insured or Actuarial rate, whichever is less payable will be payable by farmers. The difference between premium rate and the rate of Insurance charges payable by farmers shall be treated as Rate of Normal Premium Subsidy, which shall be shared equally by the Centre and State;
- 7. In case of Non-Loanee enrollment as per the scheme provisions, the required area sown certificate is required for the Non-Loanee enrollment, in favour of the respective Insurance Companies, will be made available by the District Officers of the Horticulture;
- 8. The "Reference Weather Station" (RWS) will mean the RWS as specified in Annexure–II. However, in case of any dispute, IMD station / the weather station of State Government / KVK / Agriculture Universities will be referred to for final claim settlement. In case of non-functioning or any other technical difficulties in weather data collection from any particular RWS, the weather data of the neighbouring Block(/s) may be considered with due prior intimation to the Food Processing Industries & Horticulture Department. Parameters regarding consideration of RWS are to be followed strictly as per the instructions of Government of India;
- Crop wise, area wise maximum limit of sum insured broadly equivalent to the cost of cultivation has been prefixed by the respective insurance companies'
- 10. The Implementing Agencies shall make adequate publicity / awareness of the schemes in all the notified unit areas in terms of Para—XVIII of Operational Guidelines of PMFBY/RWBCIS. They will give list of proposed publicity plan in writing along with modalities in the technical bid. They will have to take additional measures, if so requested by the State Government. The programmes will include (a) Display of hoardings/ flex banners in prominent places in every block/ Gram Panchayat/ subdivision/ district
 - (b) Participation in agricultural fairs at Block/Subdivision/districts level promoted by District administration
 - (c) Regular publicity in print/electronic media
 - (d) Holding farmers' camp
 - (e) Participation in farmers' financial inclusion / crop insurance awareness programme organised by State Government
- 11. For clarity of the farmers, all materials for circulation with regard to the Restructured Weather Based Crop Insurance Scheme (RWBCIS) for Horticultural Crops should be in lucid Bengali language only and top most priority to be ensured for wide publicity, especially at places where the farmers visit frequently, like Gram Panchayat Offices, Block Development Offices, ADO Office, Banks, Post Offices, etc. Publicity plans are to be Informed to the District Horticulture Officers and the Department of Food Processing Industries & Horticulture, so as to maximise enrolment;
- 12. Welfare Activities: The selected Implementing Agencies will promote various activities for socioeconomic development of the farmers like inclusion of Non-Loanee farmers in KCC fold /activation
 of inoperative KCC accounts in close liaison with Banks /eligible Financial Institutions. Other areas
 of activities will be setting up of demonstration center for promotion of organic farming, innovative
 practices in farm mechanization, minor irrigation etc. at Block level in consultation with District
 Horticultural Officer (DHO), respectively for RWBCIS, of the district and also participate in State
 Government led programmes launched by the Department of Agriculture;

- 13. Enrolment of Non-Loanee farmers: The selected implementing Agency will take all due care to enrol Non-Loanee farmers. Sufficient steps to be taken to prove the authenticity of Non-Loanee farmers through 1. Valid KYC documents 2. Area sown/likely to be sown certificate from ADA/RO for blocks/KPS at GP and DHO/SDHO/Field Assistant (format will be provided by the Agriculture Department and Food Processing Industries & Hortlculture Department respectively). Verification of land documents particularly in respect of crop plots proposed to be ensured. Implementing Agencies have to ensure that non-agricultural land are not included in proposed insured area.
- 14. For monitoring, supervision and implementation of the scheme, committees at State level, District level and Block level have been / will be formed and the concerned Insurance Company will be responsible to participate. The recommendation and non-recommendation by these committees will be vital for further proceedings.
- 15. The selected insurance companies / Implementing Agencies will take effective measures in respect of data entry of all requisite information in the Crop Insurance Portal (www.agri-insurance.gov.in) in time bound manner.
- 16. Any other point left out shall be dealt in terms of the Operational Guidelines of PMFBY and RWBCIS as the case may be and these may be downloaded from DAC&FW site (www.agricoop.nic.in)
- 17. The selected insurance companies / Implementing Agencies will take all due effort to reach target of both Loanee and Non-Loanee farmers as will be specified in work order. The insurance coverage in terms of number of farmers and hectare-age should be at least at the previous season's level (under PMFBY) otherwise, insurance company shall be liable to be de-barred for next bidding in the State.
- 18. Insurance Agencies may tie up with IRDA-approved insurance intermediaries for improved coverage of Non-Loanee farmers; however, they will send format information with contact details to the respective Departments and respective District Horticulture Officer.
- 19. Season-wise and crop-wise Notification / Work order will be issued from time to time.
- Seasonality Discipline: In case of modification, the same will be duly notified and the selected companies will have to comply the same.

- 21. Bank Services Charges: Bank and other financial institutions etc. shall be paid service charges as per rates fixed by appropriate authority / Government of India (present rate is @4% of the premium collected from banks). Rural agents engaged in providing insurance related services to farmers may be paid appropriate commission as decided by the insurance company, subject to cap prescribed under IRDAI regulations.
- 22. Additional Roles of Insurance Companies:

The selected Implementing Agencies will -

- Maintain a separate account for receipt of farmers' share of premium from the state government & state government share of premium subsidy for verification as required by the Government.
- They will provide regular progress returns/ statistics/information to State and Central Government.
- Submit reports to State and Central Government.
- Ensure 100% coverage of the Loanee farmers through Banks/Financial Institution, etc.
- Facilitate the bank branches/ intermediarles/ agents the details of insured farmers and beneficiaries, both Loanee & Non-Loanee, with all requisite details in prescribed formats by the state Department of agriculture and upload the data on Crop Insurance portal well in time.
- Distribute Declaration form/proposal form Loanee & Non-Loanee farmers to bank/financial
 institution branch/s. The requisite forms to be uniform across the Implementing Agencies to be
 prepared in discussion with the State Government (sample to be provided by Department of Food
 Processing Industries & Horticulture).
- The coverage of Loanee farmers should be carried out by insurance companies themselves, use
 of agents / brokers are not allowed. Claim processing and payment to Banks/Farmers within the
 prescribed timelines.
- Insurance company will ensure the marketing and publicity of the scheme as per the plan attached
 in the bid document and also asked by the State/Central Govt, and will submit advance detailed
 programme and report with photographs to State and Central Government.
- Insurance company will provide toll free number to be operated in Bengali/Nepati within one week
 from issue of work order where farmers can approach for redressals of grievance, intimate claims
 in case of localized calamity, seek information on coverage, etc.
- Redressal of all Public Grievances within the time fixed by IRDAt/State Government. The Implementing Agencies will provide summary report on action taken on regular basis.
- 23. All admissible payouts/compensations/claims shall be the responsibility of the respective insurance companies and they are liable to pay the claim within 45 (forty-five) days of closing of the insurance period subject to the receipt of actual weather data from RWSs, failing which the Insurance Company has to pay an interest @12% per annum of the claim settlement amount, to be assessed on the basis of number of days delayed. There is no responsibility of the State Government in payment of payouts/compensations/claims;
- 24. The operation of the Restructured Weather Based Crop Insurance Scheme (RWBCIS) for Horticultural Crops will be closely monitored by the Department of Food Processing Industries & Horticulture, Government of West Bengal, Department of Agriculture (Crop Insurance Branch), Government of West Bengal and Agriculture Insurance Company of India Limited, so as to make an



assessment for its effectiveness. Therefore, all the insurance companies will submit the list of both Loanee and Non-Loanee farmers covered under the Restructured Weather Based Crop Insurance: Scheme (RWBCIS) for Horticultural Crops for the Kharif Season, 2017, mentioning their names, addresses, etc., duly authenticated / countersigned by the respective District Officers of the Horticulture Directorate, to the Department of Food Processing Industries & Horticulture, Government of West Bengal. They must also ensure that all the Loanee and Non-Loanee farmers covered are actually farmers growing the notified crops;

- 25. All insurance companies will draw funds, i.e., subsidy part of the premium, as per scheme provisions. The premium subsidies on the part of the State Government, in respect of these notified crops, will be borne by the Department of Food Processing Industries & Horticulture, Government of West Bengal;
- 26. For any dispute arising between the Insurer and insured farmer, the Additional Chief Secretary / Principal Secretary / Secretary to Govt. of West Bengal, Department of Food Processing Industries & Horticulture will act as the Appellate Authority;
- 27. Failure of the successful Bidder to comply with the above requirements shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award;
- 28. All the disputes raised over the decisions of the Appellate Authority will be settled in Kolkata jurisdiction.
